### **Draw Structures**

#### **Junior Boys – 25 Teams**

- 2 pools of 6 and 2 pools of 7 round robin
- 1-8 QF, SF & F for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> qualifiers in each pool
- 9-16 QF, SF & F for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> qualifiers in each pool
- 17-20 Lower 4 round robin for 5<sup>th</sup> qualifiers in each pool
- 21-25 Bottom 5 round robin 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> qualifiers in each pool
  - Result from pool play carry over for 6<sup>th</sup> Pool D V 7<sup>th</sup> Pool D

#### **Junior Girls – 11 Teams**

- 1 pool of 11 round robin
- 1-4 SF & F for 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
- 5-8 SF & F for 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
- 9-11 bottom 3 round robin for 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> qualifiers

#### **Senior Boys – 39 Teams**

- 2 pools of 10 and 2 pools of 11 round robin
- SF's and F's for qualifiers 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>
  - 1-4 1<sup>st</sup> qualifiers
  - 5-8 2<sup>nd</sup> qualifiers
  - 9-12 3<sup>rd</sup> qualifiers
  - 13-16 4<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
  - 17-20 5<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
  - 21-24 6<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
  - 25-28 7<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
  - 29-32 8<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
  - 33-36 9<sup>th</sup> qualifiers
- 37-39 Bottom 3 round robin for 10<sup>th</sup> qualifiers

#### **Senior Girls – 15 Teams**

- 1 pool of 7, 1 pool of 8 round robin
- 1-8 QF, SF & F for 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> qualifiers in each pool
- 9-15 QF, SF & F for 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Qualifiers from each pool
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Pool B V BYE, SG 9-15 QF2
  - Loser 9-15 QF3 V BYE for 13-15 SF2
  - Loser 13-15 SF1 = 15<sup>th</sup> Place

### **Draw**

BBNZ cannot guarantee that team requests will be catered for in the draw, but have tried to accommodate where possible. Please be aware, as there are many teams making similar requests not all could be fulfilled.



### Seeding/ Pools

Seeding of teams is taken from the final team placing of the 2017 Secondary School 3x3 Tournament . Results from external (non BBNZ) competitions and/or tournaments are not used in the seeding process. If there is more than one team that did not compete at the 3x3 Champs in the previous year BBNZ will seed the teams at their discretion.

### Referees/Coaches/ Players Meeting

There will a meeting at **9am Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> March** at the ASB Arena that all referees, coaches and players must attend to go over the rules of 3X3. Even if you do not have a game first round, this meeting is compulsory. All attending and Referees please make sure you are on time!

### Score Bench

Your team will be rostered to do score bench duty. Please provide three competent score bench personnel for your duty. Every effort will be made to assist teams when able. As Hosts we do not have the capabilities to provide for every game. Please be respectful of these requests. A roster will be sent to all teams prior to the start of the tournament.

### Score Sheets

Please ensure that all players are listed on the team roster as no further changes will be allowed to players named after the technical meeting. All further score sheets will be completed for your team and can be located at tournament control. Please inform the tournament organisers if player numbers are to be changed during the tournament. *Once a team's first game commences, only those players listed on the scoresheet for the first game may participate in the remainder of that Tournament as players. [BBNZ Internal Regulations F1.5].*

### Team Roster

Please ensure that all your players are registered with the BBNZ office and are eligible to compete in the tournament and that all players comply with BBNZ and NZSSSC rules and regulations. Reminder that a maximum of 5 players only can participate in the tournament.

### Important Details

- Forfeit of Game - \$100 fine.
- **Team Benches** – Sitting at the scorebench; Team A **MUST** sit to the left (light uniforms) and Team B **MUST** sit to the right (dark uniforms). Please ensure all games start correctly with this procedure. Only the rostered players are allowed to sit on the team bench. All supporters and coach/manager must sit in the stands.
- The 3x3 Champs will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, Official FIBA 3X3 Basketball Rules of the Game with outlined amendment made by Basketball New Zealand and NZSSC Regulations and Eligibility. Please use the BBNZ web link - [HERE](#) to obtain the rules of the game.

### **Disputes Procedure**

In the unlikely event of a dispute the procedure is: the team captain is to sign the bottom of the score sheet in the box provided within 20 minutes of the completion of the game. The team then has one hour to lodge a written report and pay a bond payment of \$100 to the Tournament Director. A Judicial Committee will be assembled to consider the dispute. The Judicial Committee is made up of three members – Technical Commissioner, Tournament Director, and the BBNZ Representative. If the Committee rules in favour of the dispute, then the bond will be refunded to the team.

### **First Aid**

- Injury reporting – the Host Association to document all injuries in conjunction with BBNZ and the Arena. If any players suffer an injury please find a tournament official for the form.
- Blood kits are available at the tournament control room
- A basic first aid kit is available from the tournament office and at the venue reception.
- Ice can be found in the tournament office. Ice is only to be used for on court injuries.

### **Health and Safety and in the event of an Emergency**
